IMPROVEMENT WORKS

You might have noticed that there is a lot of improvements happening in and around D'Eynsford Estate. **DID YOU KNOW** that over the summer, we have:

- ✓ Installed 6 LED Lighting between Belham Walk & Mary Datchelor Close.
- ✓ Organised for Community Pay Back to paint over 100m2
- ✓ Painted the stairwell of 1-6 Kimpton Court
- ✓ Installed over 25 NEW estate maps
- ✓ Created and planted new pocket garden spaces
- ✓ Installed over 6 Planters with the view of carrying out a community planting day in September.

All these works have been organised through either grants or the surplus money which the TMO have accumulated the previous years. We are now looking to carry out further improvements work to the estate and have some really exciting plans in store! To find out more or if you want to get involved in having more of a say on what improvements happens in the area you live in then, we urge you to either attend the resident meetings or join the board. 

Repairs & Maintenance

Recent estate inspections have seen a further reduction in outstanding items and several key repairs have now been completed, most notably the long planned painting of the stairs in Kimpton Court and the partial repainting of a stairwell in Mary Datchelor Close.

The repairs team have begun an ongoing programme of path & kerbing repairs as many of the trees on the estate are beginning to displace bricks and cause trip hazards. This ongoing approach should ensure that rather than having to identify each issues separately, a proactive series of repairs to each path can be carried out.

A much cleaner, fresher look has been achieved by the Community Payback Scheme from painting over some of the bare concrete. The new estate maps and lighting projects are already the subject of positive feedback.

In light of several cases identified on recent estate inspections, I would like to remind residents that mopeds and motorbikes are a serious fire hazard and should never be parked in passageways. Think about your safety and that of your neighbours and please park only in designated parking spaces.



Our board members and staff recently had a tour of the Veolia waste and recycling centre: We will be writing up a detailed summary of our visit at the next news letter but meanwhile, please remember to do the following: Don't put plastic bags in the recycling bins (keep the recycling loose) and always put the bottle caps back on the empty plastic bottles.
