The report of the results provided by CIVICA Election Services for both tenants and leaseholders were:

Question 1 - Do you wish D'Eynsford TMO to continue to manage your estate/property?

No	29	14.5%

Question 2 - Do you think that D'Eynsford TMO does a satisfactory job as manager of estate/property?

RESULT	No. Votes	% of valid vote
Yes	168	84.8%
No	30	15.2%

FLY TIPPING IS ILLEGAL

Did you know that disposing items other then household rubbish on the estate, is classified as illegal fly tipping. If you are found to be fly tipping, you could be fined up to £5000 or it could result in a prison sentence. The TMO are monitoring this and reporting those who are caught fly tipping to the environmental officers who will take legal action. CCTV footages, photos and witness statements from residents maybe used in conjunction with any legal action.
