WORK TO THE HOSTEL (TEMP ACCOMODATION)

Work on converting the temporary accommodation (hostel next to the TMO Office) from a hostel to 13 properties will begin in early 2023. The work is expected to take about a year to complete, and the project is being managed by the council. The contractors will send letters to all residents informing them of a resident meeting where they will explain the scope of the work, etc. The meeting is expected to take place in the community room in January 2023.
