### Front Door

In the coming months, the council intends to replace all the front doors on our estate. This work to replace the front entrance door to individual properties is being run and managed by Southwark Council (not TMO).

# TMO SEASIDE TRIP

Did you know that Southwark Council will be collecting food waste starting in late October? To comply with the changing law and address the climate emergency, residents will be asked to begin separating their food waste and recycling it through the new service.

**FOOD WASTE RECYCLING** 

- Step 1. They will deliver a small food waste bin (a kitchen caddy) to your home in September or October. This will include instructions on how to use it.
- Step 2. They will install a communal food waste bin, near your other communal bins, in September or October.
- Step 3. You will start using your kitchen caddy and taking food waste to your communal bin, from 14 October.
- **Step 4.** They will collect food waste every week from the communal bins, from 21 October.
